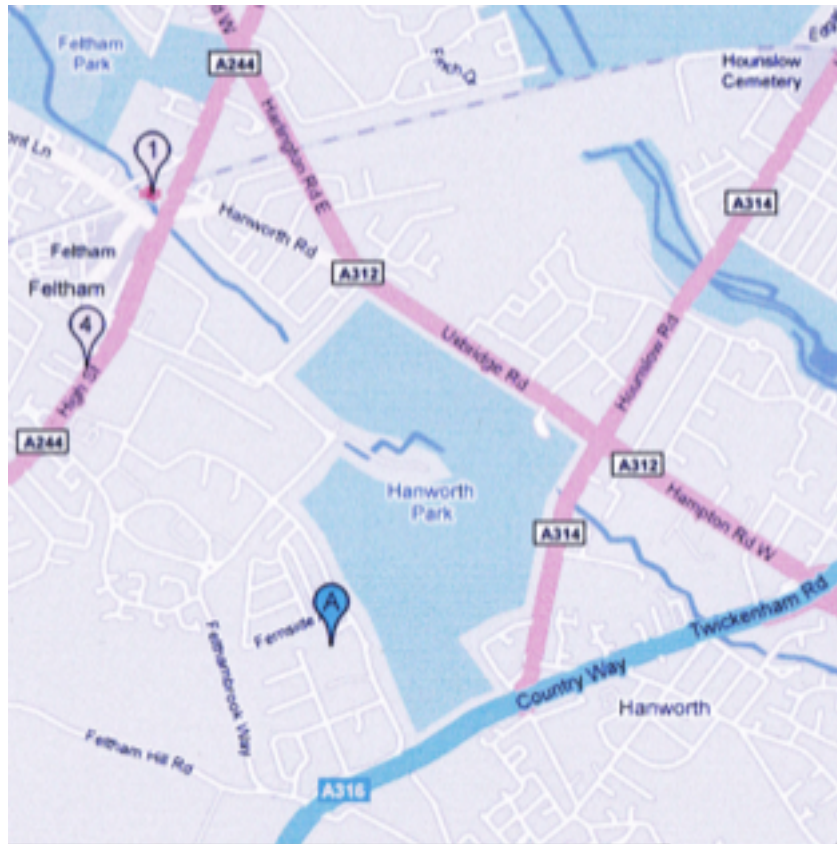

## HOW TO GET TO ST GEORGE'S CHURCH HANWORTH TW13 7QE



1 is Feltham Rail Station. A is St George's Church, Castle Way, Hanworth Park. The H26 bus will convey you the mile from Feltham Rail Station to S George's - but do cross the road and catch bus from opposite side of the road from station.

If you are coming by car, take the turning to Lower Feltham off the A316.
